Diamond Disinfectant 1000 is a concentrated EPA registered disinfectant for use in electrostatic sprayers, quart spray bottles, dilution systems or mop buckets. When diluted with water the resulting product has a neutral PH (7-8) and can be sprayed on any surface not harmed by water, and left to air dry. Diamond Disinfectant 1000 makes a Corona kill claim at a dilution of 4 ounces per 5 gallons of water. Safe on plastic.

**DIAMOND DISINFECTANT 1000** has been designed specifically for schools, hospitals, food processing plants, restaurants, and other institutions where disinfection and sanitization is of prime importance.

**DILUTION RATES**

- Corona Kill:** Add 4 oz to 5 gallons of water
- Sanitization of glassware, pots, etc:** Add 1 oz per 4 gallons of water.  
No potable rinse required.
- General Disinfection:** Add 3 ounces per 5 gallons of water.
- Hospital Disinfection:** Add 3.5 ounces per 5 gallons of water.
- E-SPRAY E1572:** Add .4 ounces per 55 oz of water.

**Warning**  
Hazardous to humans and domestic animals. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**Statement Of Practical Treatment**  
In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

**Note To Physician**  
Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
